# F3 Remedial Programme

## Schedule:

IS after school

# F3 Remedial Programme

## CHI & MATH:

- Small group teaching
- Develop basic competency

## CS & IS:

- Remedial exercises
- Develop study skills and habit
- Students have to bring textbook, dictionary and highlighter

# F3 Remedial Programme

- What happen if student is absent from the after school remedial class?
  1. To attend detention class on Monday or Thursday
  2. To complete remedial exercise
  3. To do extra work
- My son is not in the remedial class list, can he attend the class?
  - Not necessary, the remedial exercises will be available for download.

# Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA)

- TSA is a pen and paper assessment to provide the Government and school management with information on school standards in key learning areas: ENG, CHI & MATH.
- TSA is conducted at the end of P3, P6 and S3.
- TSA is mainly focused on the basic competencies.
- All the schools participate in the TSA.
- All the P3, P6 and S3 students are involved.
