- Elective Subjects to be offered:
  - BIO ( × 2)
  - CHEM ( × 2)
  - PHY ( × 2)
  - BAFS ( × 2)
  - ECON ( × 2)
  - ICT (C) ( × 1)
  - ICT (D) ( × 1)
  - CHIST ( × 1)
  - GEOG ( × 1)
  - HIST ( × 1)
  - CHI LIT ( × 1)

# Elective Subject Combinations

<b>Elective 1</b>	<b>CHEM / PHY / BAFS / ECON / CHIST</b>
<b>Elective 2</b>	<b>BIO / CHEM / PHY / ECON / ICT (C) / CHI LIT</b>
<b>Elective 3</b>	<b>BIO / BAFS / ICT (D) / HIST / GEOG</b>

- All students should take 3 elective subjects (except students who fail to meet the promotion requirements)
- Elective class size: min. = 8; max. = 32  
except ICT (C): max. = 25; & ICT (D): max. = 30
- ICT (C) & ICT (D) cannot be studied together
- MATH M1 & M2 will be offered in F5

# Number of Elective Subject Combinations

- Total number of subject combination offered: 96
- Satisfaction rate: 3Xs (75%); 2Xs (100%)

# Streaming

- Students have to meet the elective admission requirements:
  - BIO, CHEM & PHY      grade E in IS
  - BAFS      grade E in MATH
  - ECON & GEOG      grade E in CS
  - CHIST      grade E in HS
  - HIST      grade D in ENG & HS
  - ICT (C) & ICT (D)      grade E in CL
  - CHI LIT      grade D in CHI

# Streaming

- Elective subject allocation will be based on students' choices and the corresponding subject ranking in F3:
  - BIO, CHEM & PHY      IS
  - BAFS                      MATH
  - ECON & GEOG          CS
  - CHIST & HIST          HS
  - ICT (C) & ICT (D)      CL
  - CHI LIT                    CHI

# Streaming (Example)

- Student A would like to study the following elective subjects:
  - [BIO, CHEM & ICT \(D\)](#)
  - he gets grade B in IS and grade C in CL
  - his IS form ranking is 20 and his CL form ranking is 40, but 20 students have higher CL ranking than him did not choose ICT (D) in X3 as 1<sup>st</sup> priority
  - he is able to study the three elective subjects
