Scholarships and Grants

We offer scholarships and grants to eligible students, who are the best suited to and would benefit from our programmes.

Potential Development Scholarships

- For students who have attained outstanding performances academically and/or in other areas such as music, arts and sports, to cover fully or partly their tuition fees.
- Potential Development Scholarships for junior secondary are available at entry in Form 1 and is renewable upon review for consecutive years until Form 3.
- Potential Development Scholarships for senior secondary are available at entry in Form 4 and Form 6, and are renewable upon review for a consecutive year.

AWE (Activity Week Experience) Scholarships

• For students with best academic performance at each formation level so as to facilitate them joining our unique Activity Week Experience (AWE) Programmes held annually locally and overseas.

Progress Grants

- For students who need financial support, covering fully or partly their tuition fees.
- Eligibility rests on students' progress in academic performances, conduct and/or other areas such as music, arts and sports.
- Form 1 applicants may also submit the application for the Grants together with the admission application.

AWE (Activity Week Experience) Grants

• For students who need financial support and have shown satisfactory academic and conduct results, facilitating them to participate in the AWE programmes.

Other financial awards are offered to encourage students to excel in their respective areas of development and performance.
